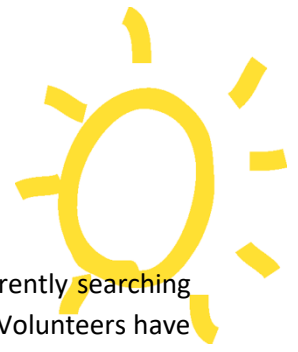


OPERATION SUMMER VOLUNTEER INFORMATION



Summer is a wonderful time to volunteer at Operation Breakthrough! We are currently searching for outstanding high school students to volunteer with our summer time programming. Volunteers have the opportunity to serve in a variety of capacities at OB. It takes time to build relationships in the lives of children; therefore, we ask high school volunteers to commit to at least 8 consecutive weeks to our program as a classroom volunteer. The consistent commitment to the classroom allows for more one-on-one positive interactions to young children who developmentally crave to be heard and seen.

What is the commitment?

If accepted into the summer volunteer program, students must be able to commit to the following:

- Must be 14 years of age or older
- Attend Orientation in April/May
 - April 25th 5:30 – 7:30 pm
 - April 27th 9:00 – 11:00 am
 - May 23rd 5:30 – 7:30 pm
 - May 25th 9:00 – 11:00 am
- Ages 14-17 will submit a Volunteer Application and Agreement
- If you are 18 you will need to complete a TB Test and Background Check
- 8 consecutive week service commitment- June 5th – July 28th 2017
- A minimum of a 2 hour classroom shift once a week either from 9:00 am-12:00 pm or 3-5:30 pm AND a minimum of a 2 hour Parent Resource shift between the hours of 1:30 – 5:00 pm
- Students have the option to complete both shifts in one day or split them between two half days.

What will I be doing?

Students can serve in a variety of ways while working in the classroom setting. Students may assist as a:

Teacher Assistant in an Early Childhood Classroom

- Assist teachers with classroom instruction and activities.
- Work one on one with children focusing on specific skills.

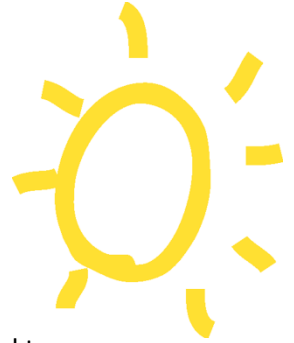
MakerSpace Assistant

- Connect with children in an environment designed for exploration, innovation, and creativity through using the principles of STEM education.

SmartLab Assistant

- The SmartLab is a classroom for students to grow and master 21st Century technological skills through self directed learning.
- Volunteers work with children individually as they explore their own projects.

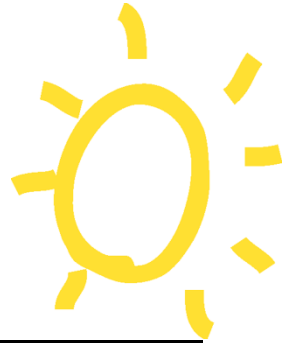
