SAFETY OFFICER

JOB SUMMARY:

This position is responsible for implementing and maintaining the safety directives of Operation Breakthrough to ensure the safety of our children, staff, parents, and visitors.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- HS Diploma or equivalent
- Basic First Aid and CPR Certification.
- Minimum two years experience in security work with a public or private entity.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

- Provide a visible presence in the public areas of Operation Breakthrough, particularly the front lobby, the Troost entrance and walkways, and parking lots.
- Assist Front Desk staff as necessary, answering questions and incoming phone calls. Assist visitors and check for visitor passes. Escort unauthorized visitors off the premises.
- Engage students and family members in cordial and constructive conversations, providing a positive adult role model.
- Walk and survey public areas regularly, intervene in verbal and physical encounters amongst adult parties. Diffuse hostile situations that might occur. Enforce organizational policies regarding weapons, traffic rules, parking and other situations that might arise.
- Assist staff and students during emergency situations and drills, including fire, tornado, bomb threats and intruder. Assist in the development of action plans to address emergency situations.
- As necessary, respond to emergency situations in classrooms involving adults.
- Report unsafe conditions and potential safety hazards to management.
- Provide a safety presence at special events and extracurricular activities sponsored by Operation Breakthrough i.e. Kindergarten Graduation, Juneteenth Celebration.
- Assist in creating and maintaining a good working relationship with the local police and fire department.
- Maintain and project a professional appearance as it relates to job performance.
- Monitor surveillance equipment as appropriate.

- Good problem-solving skills, mature attitude and mediation skills.
- Ability to relate well to children and engage them in positive conversations.
- Ability to respond to hostile situations, de-escalate verbal confrontations and intervene in physical altercations.
